



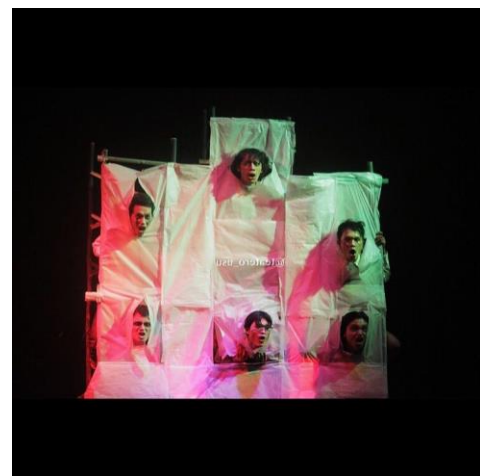
Teater O USU

6. Colossal Performances

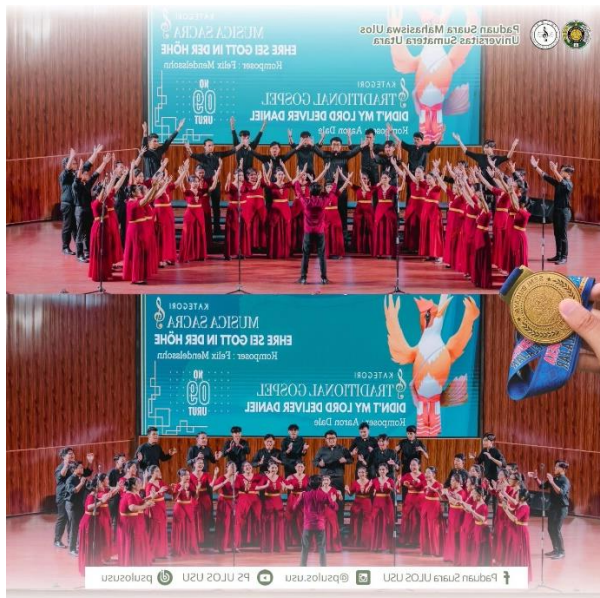

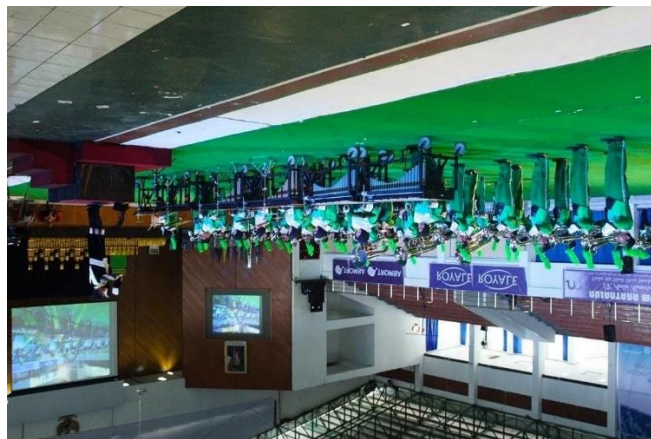
USU Marching Band
