NUMBER 5 OF 2022

ON

NEW STUDENTS ADMISSION OF USU TALENTA EXCELLENT
ACHIEVEMENT-BASED SELECTION (SBPU TALENTA) PROGRAM

BY THE GRACE OF GOD ALMIGHTY

THE RECTOR OF UNIVERSITAS SUMATERA UTARA

- Considering
- a. that in order to implement the provisions contained in the Regulation of the Minister of Education and Culture of the Republic of Indonesia Number 3 of 2020 concerning National Standards for Higher Education, it is necessary to align the Regulation of the Rector of Universitas Sumatera Utara on academic regulations;
 - b. that Universitas Sumatera Utara needs to continuously implement the USU Renstra program from 2020 to 2024 which also provides direction and objectives regarding the Academic System within Universitas Sumatera Utara;
 - c. that Universitas Sumatera Utara needs to respond to Higher Education in the Industrial Revolution 4.0 Era which is integrated into the new student admissions system;
 - d. that students are expected to not only master the fields of science that they study on campus, but also master other fields that can support their success in the future;
 - e. that as a form of appreciation for students who have achieved the achievements at the provincial, national and international, Universitas Sumatera Utara through the Academic Section has programmed New Student Admission Based on Usu Talenta Excellent Achievement-Based Selection (Sbpu Talenta) Program;
 - f. that based on the considerations aforementioned in letter a, b, c, d, e, and f, it is necessary to stipulate the Regulation of the Rector concerning New Student Admission Based on Usu Talenta Excellent Achievement-Based Selection (Sbpu Talenta) Program;

DECIDED:

To stipulate : **REGULATION OF THE RECTOR OF UNIVERSITAS SUMATERA UTARA CONCERNING NEW STUDENT ADMISSION BASED ON USU TALENTA EXCELLENT ACHIEVEMENT-BASED SELECTION (SBPU TALENTA) PROGRAM;**

**CHAPTER I
GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

Article 1

In this Regulation of the Rector, the following terms are defined:

1. Universitas Sumatera Utara, hereinafter abbreviated as USU, is a Legal Entity State University (PTN-BH).
2. Rector is an organ of USU that leads the organization and management of USU.

3. Faculty is a collection of supporting resources that can be grouped according to the department/major that organizes and manages academic, vocational, or professional education in one group of scientific, technological, humanities, and/or artistic disciplines within USU.
4. Study Program is a unit of educational and learning activities that has a specific curriculum and learning method in one type of academic, professional, and/or vocational education at USU.
5. Undergraduate Program, henceforth referred to as Program Starta Satu (S-1), is a formal academic education that prepares students to become graduates equipped with a set of academic abilities with a semester credit unit load in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
6. Vocational School is Higher Education that supports the mastery of certain applied skills, including Diploma programs that are equivalent to academic education programs. Diploma 4 is equivalent to the Undergraduate Program and graduates of vocational school will receive a vocational degree.
7. Students are learners who are legally registered in one of the vocational or academic programs at the University.
8. New Student Admission Based on Usu Talenta Excellent Achievement-Based Selection Program or abbreviated as SBPU TALENTA USU is New Student Admission Program of USU.
9. Selection is the process of selecting new students of USU, the results of which are ratified through the Decree of the Rector.
10. The Committee of SBPU TALENTA USU is a university level committee that carries out the SBPU TALENTA USU.
11. Legal Entity State University or abbreviated as PTNBH is a state university established by the government with the status of an autonomous public legal entity. Previously known as State-Owned Legal Entity and Education Legal Entity.
12. Excellent Achievement is the result of non-academic achievement of prospective students obtained during their studies at SMA/MA/SMK/MAK or equivalent, competitively and demonstrating excellence in a particular field.
13. Certificate of Achievement is a proof of achievement from the agency that organized the competition.
14. Single Tuition Fee or abbreviated as UKT is a single tuition fee borne by each student based on their economic ability.
15. Regulation of the Rector is technical implementing regulation of academic regulations set by the Rector at the University.
16. Intellectual Property Rights (HKI) is the right to obtain legal protection for intellectual property in accordance with laws and regulations in the field of HKI.
17. Hifzhil Qur'an is the ability to memorize, understand and interpret the Al-Qur'an.
18. Musabaqah Tilawatil Qur'an, hereinafter abbreviated as MTQ, is an Indonesian Islamic religious festival held at the national level which aims to glorify the Al-Qur'an. In this festival, contestants compete to recite the Al-Qur'an using Qira'at.
19. The Church Choir Festival, hereinafter abbreviated as PESPARAWI, is a choir competition event between Protestant church congregations in Indonesia which is officially organized by the Directorate General of Protestant Christian Community Guidance, Ministry of Religion of the Republic of Indonesia through the coordination of an institution called LPPN (National PESPARAWI Development Institute).
20. Science and Technology, hereinafter abbreviated as Saintek, is a study group at the Senior High School level which originates from the Natural Sciences subject group which has majors that focus on the fields of science and technology.

21. Social Humanities, hereinafter abbreviated as Soshum, is a study group at the Senior High School level which originates from the Social Sciences subject group which has majors that focus on the social and humanities fields.

CHAPTER II
NEW STUDENT ADMISSIONS PATTERNS

Part One
Purpose

Article 2

The purposes of New Student Admissions Program of SBPU TALENTA USU are:

- a. To provide opportunities for students who have achieved excellence to become students in one of the study programs at USU so that they can continue to develop their achievements;
- b. To improve the quality of new student input of USU;
- c. To provide appreciation/awards to students who have non-academic excellent achievements in championships/awards in the fields of sports, arts, spirituality, reasoning, subject field olympiads, and other field competitions or have other excellent achievements;
- d. To provide motivation to students to maintain their achievements so that they can improve the reputation of USU.

Part Two
Principle

Article 3

The New Student Admissions Pattern of SBPU TALENTA USU Program is organized with the following principles:

- a. Fair, means not discriminating based on religion, ethnicity, race, gender, social status, region, physical condition, and economic ability of prospective students, while still paying attention to the potential and academic achievements along with the non-academic achievements of prospective students and the specificities of the Study Program;
- b. Accountable, namely carried out according to clear procedures and criteria and can be accounted for;
- c. Transparent, meaning that the implementation of admission is carried out openly and the results of the implementation can be easily accessed by all parties;
- d. Distribution, namely the implementation is carried out by paying attention to the distribution of students in study programs based on their region of origin.

Part Three
Capacity

Article 4

Capacity of New Student Admissions of SBPU TALENTA USU Program:

- a. The university determines the capacity for new students by maintaining a balance between the maximum number of students in each study program and the capacity of facilities and infrastructure, lecturers, and education staff, as well as other educational services and resources;

- b. The maximum capacity accepted on this program is 0.5% (zero point five percent) of the New Student Admissions quota.

Part Four
Implementation Organization

Article 5

- (1) New Student Admissions aforementioned in Article 2 is carried out by the Committee of SBPU TALENTA USU.
- (2) The Committee of SBPU TALENTA USU as referred to in point (1) is appointed by the Rector.

CHAPTER III
REQUIREMENTS FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS

Part One
General Requirements

Article 6

In the implementation of New Student Admissions of SBPU TALENTA USU Program, prospective new students must fulfil the following requirements:

- a. Students or graduates of SMA/MA/SMK/MAK or equivalent who graduated in the current academic year and the two previous years;
- b. Winning a championship/award or having excellent achievements in a championship/award or excellent achievements of an individual/group;
- c. The championship/awards or achievements aforementioned in letter b were achieved during SMA/MA/SMK/MAK or equivalent;
- d. Be able to obey the Ethics and Rules also fulfill the requirements as a student of USU.

Part Two
Specific Requirements

Article 7

- (1) In addition to fulfilling the requirements aforementioned in Article 6, prospective new students of the Excellent Achievement-Based Selection program must have one of the following achievements or have a certificate/letter of information:
 - a. Champion/Achievement I, II, or III or received a gold, silver, or bronze trophy/medal for a championship in the fields of sports, arts, spirituality, reasoning, subject field olympiads, and other field competitions or have other excellent achievements obtained while in SMA/MA/SMK/MAK or equivalent;
 - b. Other skills/abilities or excellent achievements proven by a certificate or letter of reference from an official institution established and/or recognized by the government which is the organizer of the excellent skills/abilities or excellent achievements program;

- c. Expertise/ability in the field of Spirituality, specifically in the field of Hifzhil Qur'an, at least 5 (five) Juz, obtained while in SMA/MA/SMK/MAK or equivalent;
- (2) The Champions/Achievements aforementioned in point (1) letter a are The 1st Champions/Achievements at the Regency/City, The 1st and 2nd Champions/Achievements at the Provincial, The 1st, 2nd, 3rd Champions/Achievements at the National, and Champions/Achievements in all categories at the International.
 - (3) Proof of certificates, championship charters or letters of reference regarding excellent achievements/abilities aforementioned in point (1) must be validated by the head of the local office or authorized official/supervisor.
 - (4) Champions/Achievements of sports aforementioned in point (1) letter a which are recognized are Multi Event championships for all sports branches which are organized by KONI or Government Agencies and are official championships which are recognized by the main sports organization which is proven by authentic evidence in the form of certificates and recommendations from the Main Sports Organization/KONI.
 - (5) Champions/Achievements of Spirituality aforementioned in point (1) letter a for Islamic Spirituality that are recognized are achievements organized by relevant government agencies or BUMN and are institutional, including:
 - a. MTQ category of Tilawah Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - b. MTQ category of Tartil Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - c. MTQ category of Hifzhil Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - d. MTQ category of Syarh Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - e. MTQ category of Fahm Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - f. MTQ category of Al-Qur'an Calligraphy Branch;
 - g. MTQ category of Written Works on the Contents of the Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - h. MTQ category of Tafsir Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - i. MTQ category of Qira'at Al-Qur'an Branch;
 - (6) Champions/Achievements of Spirituality aforementioned in point (1) letter a for Protestant Christian Spirituality which are recognized are achievements organized by relevant government agencies or BUMN and are institutional, such as the PESPARAWI championship, including:
 - a. Champion of the Female Teenage Solo Singer Category-Pesparawi;
 - b. Champion of the Male Teenage Solo Singer Category-Pesparawi;
 - c. Champion of the Youth Choir Category -Pesparawi (Group)
 - d. Champion of the Vocal Group Category -Pesparawi (Group);
 - e. Champion of Church Pop Music Category (Group);
 - f. Best Conductor/Headmaster
 - (7) Except for the provisions in point (2), the champions/achievements of Arts aforementioned in point (1) who are recognized are individual champions of national-scale talent search competitions held by government agencies or BUMN or Private Parties.
 - (8) Inventor of Appropriate Technology proven by Patent, Copyright or other Intellectual Property Rights (HKI) issued by the Ministry of Law and Human Rights of the Republic of Indonesia.
 - (9) Pass the test and interview by the Selection Team.

CHAPTER IV
SELECTION SYSTEM

Part One
Selection System

Article 8

- (1) The Committee of SBPU TALENTA USU determines the new student admission selection system based on a separate selection system implemented by USU.
- (2) The selection of SBPU TALENTA USU is conducted 1 (once) in a year.
- (3) The determination of the selection implementation time is determined by the Rector together with the appointment of the Committee of SBPU TALENTA USU with a work period of 1 (one) year.

Part Two
Study Program

Article 9

- (1) Prospective participants can choose a maximum of two Vocational and/or Undergraduate study programs at USU.
- (2) The order in which study programs are selected indicates the priority of choice.
- (3) The Study Programs that can be selected are only Study Programs that provide options according to the majors of the SMA/MA/SMK/MAK or equivalent.

Part Three
Determination of Passing

Article 10

- (1) The pass of participants is determined by the Rector based on the results of the selection conducted by the Committee of SBPU TALENTA USU.
- (2) The participants who are declared to have passed will also be considered for the possibility of obtaining a reduction in UKT fees per semester and/or proposed to receive a scholarship in accordance with applicable provisions.
- (3) The announcement of participants who have passed will be announced via website of www.usu.ac.id.

Article 11

- (1) The participants of SBPU TALENTA USU who have passed the selection:
 - a. It is mandatory to carry out administrative registration for re-registration according to the specified schedule;
 - b. It is not permitted to transfer to another study program;
 - c. It is declared to have failed if they do not carry out administrative registration for re-registration in accordance with the provisions; or are proven to have falsified data/committed fraud/provided information that does not correspond to the actual situation.
- (2) Changes to the schedule and other matters relating to SBPU TALENTA USU are announced via website of www.usu.ac.id.

Article 12

All passed participants are required:

- a. To follow a Physical Health and Color Blindness test for Study Programs that require No Color Blindness;
- b. To present the latest Drug-Free Certificate from the USU Hospital;
- c. To present a certificate stating that no criminal offense has ever been committed.

Article 13

The Committee of SBPU TALENTA USU may make further Technical Instructions to regulate matters required in the implementation of this Regulation of the Rector as long as it does not change and/or contradictory with the provisions in this Regulation of the Rector.

Article 14

This Regulation of the Rector come into force on the date of stipulation.
